ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

“Making a good script great”: in five words this title of Linda Seger’s most popular book sums up the task of the script consultant. Like any good artist or craftsman, a screenwriter may need the support of a trained set of fresh eyes to help them deliver a successful project, especially when things get stale.

Being experts in the art and craft of screenwriting, script consultants work closely with writers, giving feedback on the quality of the screenplay, suggesting improvements, or ensuring practical issues like continuity and running time. In this process, script consultants need to be constructive and diplomatic, and they should be familiar with the needs and working principles of the screenwriter.

Aiming at professionals in positions working with writers in the story development process, this five-day seminar explores all core areas of the work of a script consultant. In a mixture of lectures, case studies and exercises, topics explored range from knowledge to abilities, from screenwriting craft to communication skills.

In addition to a group of up to 15 participants, who will be actively working with scripts and excerpts provided by Linda Seger, this class is open to a limited number of interested observers.

ABOUT THE TEACHER

Dr. Linda Seger created and defined the career of script consultant in 1981, when she developed a method for analyzing scripts for her dissertation project. Since then, she has consulted on over 2,000 scripts including over 50 produced feature films and over 35 produced television projects. Her clients include Ray Bradbury, William Kelley, Linda Lavin and production companies, film studios, producers, directors, and writers from over thirty countries. Projects include Peter Jackson’s “Brain Dead”, Roland Emmerich’s “Universal Soldier”, “Pasttime”, “Picture Bride”, “The Neverending Story II”, “Luther”, “Romero”, the Danish-Swedish mini-series “The Bridge”, and many others.

In addition, Linda has taught and lectured in over 30 countries on 6 continents. She has given seminars for studios, networks, ABC, NBC, CBS, RAI Television, ZDF, production companies, television series (“MacGyver”, “The Mary Show”), film commissions, universities, and film schools. Linda has written 15 books, 9 of them on screenwriting, including the best-selling “Making a Good Script Great”, “Creating Unforgettable Characters”, and “Writing Subtext”. She received a Lifetime Achievement Award from the Redemptive Film Festival, the Candlelight Award for being a “Light to the Entertainment Industry,” the Distinguished Alumni Award from Pacific School of Religion, The Moondance Film Festival Living Legacy Award for her support of women in the film industry, and The Colorado College Benezet Award for innovation in her field.
